Children's Bags.

Please remember these are accessible to the children. Therefore for safety reasons please do not leave sun cream, medication etc. in your child's bag.

Calpol

As you will be aware Calpol is a form of paracetamol. As adults we take paracetamol to relieve pain, this is the same for children. Therefore if it has been necessary for your child to have Calpol (or other pain relief) before attending Pre School it may be that your child should be at home, as Pre School is not the place for an unwell child. If you feel your child is able to attend after having medicine then it is important for you inform Pre School staff of what medicine and dose has been administered and the time it was given.
